

Panamá Conecta's AI-Built Fuel Subsidy Platform — Rapid Development, National-Scale Uptake

Panama's government innovation agency AIG says it used AI-assisted development to build the digital fuel-subsidy platform in three weeks for \$45,000, versus roughly ten months and \$5 million for a prior comparable system; independent press count over a million monthly transaction
