

Panama's National AI-Ready Laptop Rollout for Public School Teachers

Panama's education ministry is investing \$26.6 million to equip 54,000 public-school teachers with AI-capable, offline-functioning laptops and Intel-developed training; 15,000 units and training for roughly half the teaching corps have already been delivered.
