

PARE 1+1 — Moldova's Diaspora Remittance-Matching Programme for Returnee Entrepreneurs

Summary

Moldova matches migrant remittances invested in a new business leu-for-leu with a state grant. Since 2010 it backed 739 businesses and drew 564 migrants home, with 84% outside the capital, though an IOM-linked evaluation flagged weak impact tracking.
