Summary

Plan Vivo-certified community carbon project in La Mosquitia—Honduras's last large primeval forest. Miskito fire brigades protect 1,600+ ha of pine savanna; ~400 ha of forest recovering by 2022; 319 families earn 61% of carbon-credit revenue. Credits vintage 2023–2024.
