Summary

Bologna's 2014 regulation lets citizen groups sign 'Pacts of Collaboration' with the city to co-manage public spaces. Over 400 pacts have been signed, and roughly 280 Italian municipalities have since adopted the model, though evaluation found uneven economic sustainability.
