

PIGR — Portugal's Social Security Launches an AI Platform to Flag Fraud Risk Before It Happens

Portugal's Social Security went live in October 2025 with an AI platform that scans internal records for behavioural risk patterns among employers, aiming to catch fraud before it happens. A citizen-facing module is planned; no results are public yet.
