

Pikin Tab — Imagine Worldwide's Solar-Powered Tablet Learning Programme in Sierra Leone

Summary

Solar-powered, offline tablets deliver adaptive literacy and numeracy lessons in rural Sierra Leone schools, partnered with the Ministry of Education since 2023. It targets 217,000 children in 751 schools by 2026; early data show twice as many reading fluently after a year.
