

PLLuM in Gdynia — Poland's First City to Deploy Its Sovereign AI Model for Residents and Officials

Summary

Gdynia became the first Polish city to put PLLuM, the state-backed Polish AI model, to work — powering a resident search engine for its Public Information Bulletin and a city chatbot, under an October 2025 deal with the government's NASK-led HIVE AI consortium.
