

Poznań's Retention-Linked Stormwater Fee — Aquanet's Avoided-Cost Discount Scheme (Poland)

Summary

Poznań's water utility Aquanet discounts stormwater fees by roughly 15% for properties that retain over 20% of rainfall on-site, pairing the price signal with municipal grants for rain gardens and retention tanks.
