Summary

PM Modi's monthly PRAGATI sessions combine geospatial dashboards and live ministry data to unblock stalled projects. As of 2026: 50 sessions, 382 projects (■85 lakh crore, ~\$1 trillion), 94% of 3,187 issues resolved. PRAGATI 2.0 (2023) expanded to social programmes.
