

Praxis asbl — Evaluated Group Programme for Intimate-Partner-Violence Perpetrators in French-Speaking Belgium

Summary

Praxis asbl has run 21-week accountability groups for IPV perpetrators across French-speaking Belgium since 2000; an independent study found an 18% two-year reoffending rate among graduates, versus 54% for those who only got a fine or prison sentence.
