

Prayatna Nepal's Disability-Led Digital Accessibility Audit and Validation Workshop

Summary

Prayatna Nepal, an organisation led by visually impaired women, audited 20 government and private websites and 10 mobile apps against WCAG and convened 47 stakeholders in Kathmandu to validate findings and shape Nepal's digital accessibility guidelines.
