Summary

Israel's Ministry of Education piloted AI-personalised English teaching in 28 middle schools in 2025–26, backed by a NIS 1bn+ national AI-education budget, with expansion to 180 schools and maths/science planned for 2026–27. Outcome results were still pending at announcement.
