Project Sinxay, run by Laos' Youth Union with UNICEF and chipmaker Arm's 'AI in Play' fund, has trained over 1,000 Lao youth in four-day AI-literacy bootcamps with a built-in 50% girls quota, plus AI captioning and image-recognition tools for participants with hearing or visual i
