

Prometea — Buenos Aires' AI for judicial ruling prediction and prosecution automation

Summary

Buenos Aires' Ministerio Público Fiscal deployed Prometea in 2017 to predict judicial outcomes and automate ruling drafts. 1,000 labour-rights rulings: 5 days (vs 83). Housing rights: 45 days (vs 174). 96% accuracy. Open-source; adopted by Colombia's Constitutional Court.
