

Ravenstvo (Equality): Kyrgyzstan's Disability-Led Response to Gender-Based Violence

Summary

Ravenstvo, a Kyrgyz women-with-disabilities-led NGO, delivers counselling, training and advocacy against gender-based violence. UN-backed surveys found up to 93% of disabled women had faced abuse; its work coincided with 2025 Kyrgyz law reforms toughening penalties.
