Summary

The Republic of Congo's FCPF ERPA—signed May 2021—commits up to US\$41.8 million for verified emission reductions across 12.4 million ha of tropical forest in Sangha and Likouala Departments, making it the 6th African and 13th global FCPF Carbon Fund signatory.
