

RESILAND CA+ Tajikistan Resilient Landscape Restoration Project — Vakhsh Catchment

Evidence strength: Descriptive / self-reported

Summary

A \$45M World Bank IDA grant, approved Feb 2022, funds forest, pasture and soil-erosion restoration across southern Tajikistan's Vakhsh catchment, where erosion affects 70% of arable land; a study estimates mosaic restoration of ~1M ha could yield \$8.3bn in benefits over 30 years.
