

Romania's Digital Accessibility Law, One Year On — Wawsome Finds Most Company Sites Still Fail Basic Tests

Summary

One year after Romania's EU accessibility deadline, platform Wawsome found about nine in ten evaluated company sites still had significant barriers — poor contrast, missing alt text, broken keyboard navigation — showing a legal deadline alone did not shift practice.
