

Rumiyacu–Mishquiyacu–Almendra Water Fund — EPS Moyobamba's Pioneering Tariff-Based Watershed PES (Peru)

Summary

Since 2008, a one-sol water-tariff surcharge in Moyobamba has funded reforestation 400 ha across three microwatersheds feeding the city's supply, predating Peru's national MERESE law by six years and projected to cut sediment loads by up to 25,000 tonnes over 20 years.
