Summary

A \$30M World Bank IDA grant funded 526 matching grants and rural infrastructure for tourism and agribusiness MSMEs in Tajikistan's Gorno-Badakhshan and Khatlon regions (2019–2024), creating an estimated 1,500 jobs and expanding women-led tourism businesses.
