Under Zambia's GRZ-UN Joint Programme on Gender-Based Violence, UNDP and ZICTA opened ICT hubs at schools in Chongwe, Chisamba and Itezhi-Tezhi, equipping over 700 rural women and girls with digital literacy, digital-finance and online-safety skills since April 2024.
