Vietnam's first high-tech zone (2002): 160 projects, US\$12.3B committed capital, 52,000+ workers, US\$20.7B in high-tech exports in 2024 (+18% YoY). Intel, Samsung, Nidec, and Jabil anchor a park expanding from 326 ha to 913 ha.
