Independently audited by SGS, Sanpellegrino's Ruspino bottling plant achieved AWS Core Certification in 2020 for its stewardship of the San Pellegrino, Limpia and Brembo aquifers, with a catchment water balance of +2.3M m³/yr and a 20% cut in water withdrawal over four years.
