Summary

ILO and Egypt's Federation of Industries piloted SCORE lean-management training with 30 engineering and chemical SMEs in Qalioubia and Menoufia; most reported cost savings, fewer defects and better working conditions, prompting a EUR2.5m Italian-funded scale-up to new sectors.
