Summary

Papua New Guinea's DICT unveiled SevisPass on 27 November 2025: a TECH5-built biometric digital identity and SevisWallet, Oceania's first decentralised digital-public-infrastructure ID system, following a 2024 pilot and a Cabinet-approved 2025 policy.
