Summary

An AfDB-financed programme paired micro-lending through Seychelles' Small Business Finance Agency with entrepreneurship training via the Small Enterprise Promotion Agency, financing 716 MSMEs by 2020 and lifting loan-recovery rates from under 30% to 90%, though results are large
