Singapore's MOE issued a 2024 AI-in-Education Ethics Framework (Agency, Inclusivity, Fairness, Safety) on IMDA's national AI governance model, enforced by requiring AI tools on the free Student Learning Space to use local training data and pass a whitelisting review.
