Summary

Since 2010, Chile's Law 20.412 has paid smallholder and family farmers via INDAP/SAG competitive rounds to restore degraded agricultural soils; 2025 Biobío-region rounds alone approved 561 management plans covering over 1,000 ha for roughly 676 million pesos.
