

SISOCS — Honduras' Infrastructure Open-Data Portal That Took Disclosure from 27% to 95%

Summary

Honduras' CoST-backed SISOCS portal grew from 13 disclosed infrastructure projects in 2014 to 2,038 projects worth US\$1.1bn by 2021, lifting mandated data disclosure from 27% to about 95% and training over 500 citizen monitors — before CoST Honduras' membership went inactive in 2
