

Sistema Alerta Niñez — Chile's Machine-Learning Score for Children at Risk of Rights Violations

Quality score: 27/100

Evidence strength: Observational / pre–post

Summary

Since 2019, Chile's Subsecretariat of Social Evaluation has piloted a machine-learning risk score prioritising at-risk children in 12 communes. Seven years on it remains pilot-only, and researchers found no public documentation of the model or its accuracy.
