

SITA — Nepal's AI Platform Turning Months of Survey Analysis Into Seconds

Summary

Nepal's Ministry of Health and Population and UNFPA, with Google and the British Embassy, built SITA, an AI platform for querying national survey data in plain language. A pilot on the Demographic and Health Survey matched human analysis 100% of the time, halving analysis time.
