Summary

Russia's state-backed innovation city grew from its 2010 founding to roughly 2,500-2,700 resident companies with over \$1.5bn in 2019 revenue and hundreds of foreign patents, but a 2013 prosecutors' probe found about \$1.6bn in misused development funds.
