Summary

Singapore's IMDA-led SMEs Go Digital programme has supported ~88,000 SMEs since 2017 via tiered digital grants. A 2023 impact evaluation found productivity gains up to 6.4% for micro firms, with sector-specific solutions nearly twice as effective as generic ones.
