

# SMILE — Co-Creating a Smart Living Ecosystem for Ageing in Place

### Summary

An EU Horizon 2020 project (2021–2024, €5.9M) co-created a smart-home AI ecosystem — a Digital Care Facilitator and conversational agent — with older people living with dementia, COPD or post-surgery needs, across pilot sites in Norway, Denmark, the Netherlands and Canada.
