

Snowchange Cooperative — Landscape Rewilding Programme (Finland)

Summary

Snowchange Cooperative, an Indigenous- and community-led NGO, has rewetted boreal peatlands across Finland — the 110-ha Linnunsuo mire and 874 ha of the Koitajoki basin (by 2023) — without pursuing carbon credits, citing unresolved boreal-peat GHG methodologies.
