Tajikistan's World Bank-funded resilience project (2020-2025) trained over 10,000 disadvantaged youth in Khatlon and Gorno-Badakhshan in digital literacy, entrepreneurship and critical thinking, raising women's participation in project decisions from 0% to 56%.
