Summary

Turkey's ■ÖN■M one-stop centres, run under Law 6284 since 2013, expanded from 49 to all 81 provinces and reported 1.28 million people served by late 2022, but no independent audit of caseloads or re-victimisation outcomes has been published, and GREVIO flagged coverage gaps.
