

SpectrumSphere — Testing Teacher Adoption of an AI/VR/AR Learning Platform for Autistic Students in Spain

Evidence strength: Moderate

Summary

A peer-reviewed pilot surveyed 30 special-education teachers in Spain's Valencian Community on their intention to adopt SpectrumSphere, an AI/VR/AR/AAC learning platform for autistic students, finding perceived usefulness and self-efficacy as the strongest adoption predictors.
