Summary

Trinidad and Tobago's EU-UN Spotlight Initiative (2019-2023) trained health staff and fed into a National Strategic Action Plan on GBV (2023-2027); PAHO-backed training reached 22 staff directly with a cascade target above 250, against a reported 140% rise in 2020 abuse cases.
