Summary

A public-private consortium — Armenia's Ministry of Education, Synopsys Armenia, AGBU and the ICT employers' union — piloted a three-year AI/ML school curriculum in 6 schools; 64 students completed it in 2023–24 before a nationwide MoU expansion and 2025 ministry accreditation.
