

Studiosity+ at the University of Bedfordshire — A Published Evaluation of AI-Augmented Writing Feedback

Summary

Bedfordshire ran a published evaluation comparing its human-tutor Studiosity writing service with a new AI-augmented version. The 2024 AI trial cut average feedback turnaround from 5 hours to 2 minutes and recorded 11-21.5% grade gains in a single-institution comparison.
