

Subsidised Advisory Vouchers for SMEs — EBRD's Advice for Small Businesses in Georgia

Summary

Since 2003, EBRD advisers have run ~1,150 subsidised consulting projects with Georgian SMEs — half outside Tbilisi, a fifth women-led. Case example ASP-GEORGIA: +71% turnover, +90% staff. EU4Business reports ~170 Georgian firms reached via its EBRD credit line since 2016.
