

Suriname National REDD+ Programme — Jurisdictional Forest Carbon Results-Based Payments

Summary

Suriname (~93% forest cover) runs a national jurisdictional REDD+ programme (NIMOS/SBB) that generated ~10M tCO₂e in UNFCCC-validated results, 2018-2020. A GCF results-based payment of ~US\$80M was pending as of 2025 — governance and benefit-sharing gaps remain.
