

Suriname's EU–CDB MSME Export-Readiness Programme

Summary

A EUR 394,622 EU/Caribbean Development Bank grant is preparing 60 Surinamese MSMEs to export into Barbados, Guyana and Trinidad through branding, marketing and export-readiness training, with the Government of Suriname co-financing a quarter of the cost.
