

T-Hub — Telangana's State-Backed Startup Innovation Campus

Summary

Telangana's T-Hub, a state-backed innovation campus in Hyderabad launched in 2015, reports 4,100+ startups supported and \$2bn+ funding facilitated. These are T-Hub's own organisational figures, not independently audited, and have shifted markedly across years of self-reporting.
