Summary

Since 2016, Taipei's Smart City PMO has run nearly 600 public-private matchmaking meetings and vetted 100+ pilot proposals, converting about a third into proof-of-concept trials — from UAV disaster relief to the WeMo e-scooter service — on a roughly \$1 million annual budget.
