

TajRupt AI Lab — Four-Month Machine-Learning Training for Tajik Youth in Dushanbe and Khujand

Summary

A free four-month applied machine-learning course run by Central Asia's first AI lab, TajRupt/Zypl.ai, trained 30 young Tajiks (8 girls) in Dushanbe and Khujand; 13 finished with internships and 2 were hired as ML apprentices.
