MinTIC's free 'Talento Tech' bootcamps teach AI, data and digital skills across all 32 Colombian capitals, prioritising women, rural and low-income applicants, backed by a ~COP 466bn 2024–26 budget — though rural connectivity gaps and unverified learning outcomes remain caveats.
