Summary

Taiwan's Ministry of Digital Affairs used the open-source LLM tool Talk to the City to cluster public opinions from AI-policy 'Alignment Assemblies,' processing 2,000+ statements from 400+ participants across four 2023 workshops on AI regulation and ethics.
